Thank you for your email.

We are currently preparing our first public information evening for the proposed development which we hope to stage at the end of May or start of June. We feel that will provide the community with all the information that will be available at that time. Thank you for the offer to attend your next meeting however we would not be in a position to provide information that we intend to make public at the May/June event without having gone through the full advertisement process and notification of all local residents as per the Department of Communications, Climate Action & Environment's Code of Practice for Wind Energy Development Guidelines for Community Engagement.

Our communications with Cllr. Tobin came as a result of an information leaflet that was circulated in the area notifying local residents of the first public meeting that was held in March. We contacted Cllr Tobin as the leaflet suggested he was the organiser of the meeting which he confirmed was not the case. Besides this, all local representatives were informed about the temporary met mast should they receive enquiries from local residents
